

## Full day program at LMP

I. Rates: Rates are based on number of days in attendance as well as the age of the child.

## II. Daily schedule

### III. Lunch

LMP does not provide lunch. Families are expected to bring their own cold lunch to school. All items in a child's lunch or snack will be nut free. There is a refrigerator on site to store lunch bags. Bags are expected to go home with each child nightly.

### IV. Snack

Snack will be provided for children three times daily; during morning preschool, during afternoon preschool, and after pm outside play. Snack is ready and available for children in the classroom to take when they choose. Snack is provided by parents as a part of the school supply list and a daily menu is kept in the classroom. Parents are provided with information on USDA food guidelines on the "The Parent" tab on our website [laxmontessori.com](http://laxmontessori.com).

### V. Rest time

Children under the age of 5 and who are at school for more than 4 hours are required to have a rest time. Rest time will be after lunch and begin at 11:45. Your child will be allowed to rest for as long as they want or as long as the parents wish them to. If a child is not asleep within a half an hour they will be allowed to get up and participate in free choice work in another room. Parents are expected to provide all bedding and a nap mat for their child. These items must be taken home weekly to be washed and returned to school.

### VI. Staff

The staff to child ratio will meet or exceed the state standards as calculated daily by the ages of the children present, generally these ratios are approximately 1:8 to 1:10. There will be a minimum of two staff on site at all times when children are present during operating hours.
